Eligibility

Participants:

- ❖ Must be Refugee, Immigrant or Indigenous resident new to Saskatoon
- ❖ Interested in learning about the local cultural norms, and gaining knowledge about the community of Saskatoon
- ❖ Must be willing to share personal stories and talk about their cultural experiences

- ❖ Must be an established Saskatoon resident who has lived in Saskatoon for more than 5 years
- ❖ Willing to welcome a newcomer or indigenous person into the community, while developing leadership and intercultural skills
- ❖ Must be willing to share personal stories and talk about their cultural experiences

What is required?

- ❖ A minimum time commitment of 10 hours over 2 months
- ❖ One-to-one meetings and monthly group intercultural sessions
